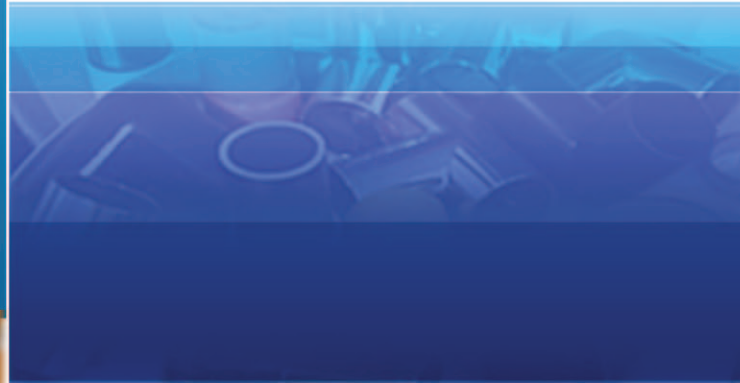

THE HISTORY OF TECHNO

Techno Plastics (Pty) Ltd was founded and registered in October 1980 by Rolf Schlub and Michael Cohen. The company commenced operation on 1 January 1981. Production started with four (4) German manufactured injection-moulding machines. The company experienced continuous growth throughout the years and today its manufacturing facilities consists of nineteen (19) machines of the same origin, as well as other various modern plastics processing equipment.

In July 1997 Techno moved to its current premises in Sebenza, about 5km from the OR Tambo International Airport, in Johannesburg (the busiest airport in Africa). The factory layout was designed to allow for optimal flow of materials and products through the shop floor facilities, ensuring high efficiency of production and high quality of manufactured product. Negotiations for the sale of the business to a Black Economic Empowerment individual started during the course of 2003. The negotiations were finally concluded in 2004 and a new company with a new registration number was formed. This resulted in a new shareholder, Musa Malinga, the current director joining the company and Michael Cohen leaving the company and emigrating to Australia.

Techno Plastics is a member of the Plastics Federation of South Africa and its former Managing Director, and now business consultant, Rolf Schlub has been awarded a Fellowship of the Plastics Institute of Southern Africa (PISA) for his contribution to the advancement of PISA and the plastics industry as a whole.

Techno Plastics is a name synonymous with high quality parts and this has been achieved by total commitment to excellence throughout all facets of the manufacturing process. Management is constantly striving to keep abreast of the latest technology in the industry, therefore maintaining the company's position as one of the leaders in its field. Constant company training programmes and remuneration based solely on merit contributes to a satisfied and therefore stable workforce with excellent prospects for advancement.

OWNERSHIP:

Techno Plastics is today owned by Rolf Schlub (minority interest) and Musa Malinga (majority interest).

In 2004 a BEE transaction was concluded whereby the majority shareholding in Techno Plastics was sold to Musa malinga. The result was that Michael Cohen was bought out completely while Rolf Schlub still retains a minority stake in the business.

Subsequently Rolf Schlub has retired with effect 31 December 2007, but has a consultancy agreement with Techno Plastics which is renewable by agreement between both parties.
